



Networking, outreach event scheduled for Prop. X school projects

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The South Bay Union School District's Proposition X construction bond program has scheduled a networking and outreach breakfast for local subcontractors and trade specialists on Feb. 26. Proposition X is a \$59.4 million bond measure that was passed by voters to modernize seven of the district's 12 elementary schools and improve windows, replace sewers and remodel bathrooms at the remaining five school sites.

There also are four other district projects included in the Proposition X bond measure: VIP Village Preschool, the Education Center, Facilities/Transportation Facility and the Purchasing/Child Nutrition Facility.

The event this Friday will give subcontractors information about upcoming contracting opportunities -- like Oneonta and Bayside Elementary schools -- as well as safety and bonding requirements.
