Proposition X Citizens' Oversight Committee to Fill Vacancy
South Bay Union School District seeks community representative

Imperial Beach, CA - The South Bay Union School District (SBUSD) is currently seeking applications from qualified individuals interested in serving as a community-at-large representative on its Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC). The committee oversees the expenditure of Prop X, the \$59.4 million school safety and repair bond currently modernizing the District's schools. Applicants must reside within the boundaries of the District to be eligible for consideration.

The Prop X COC has a firsthand role in monitoring and publicly reporting on the performance of the program and construction quality. The committee also communicates its findings to the District's Board of Trustees on a quarterly basis to ensure that funds are invested as the voters intended and that projects are completed efficiently. Current members of the committee have been appointed by the governing board of the District from a list of candidates who submitted written applications, based on criteria established by Prop 39.

Prop X is a \$59.4 million school classroom, safety and repair measure approved by South Bay voters in November 2008 that is funding the repairs and improvements needed to ensure that the District's 9,000 students are in a safe, healthy and quality learning environment. The renovations will modernize classrooms, restrooms and cafeterias; improve handicap accessibility; make health and safety improvements and improve student access to computers and modern technology.
